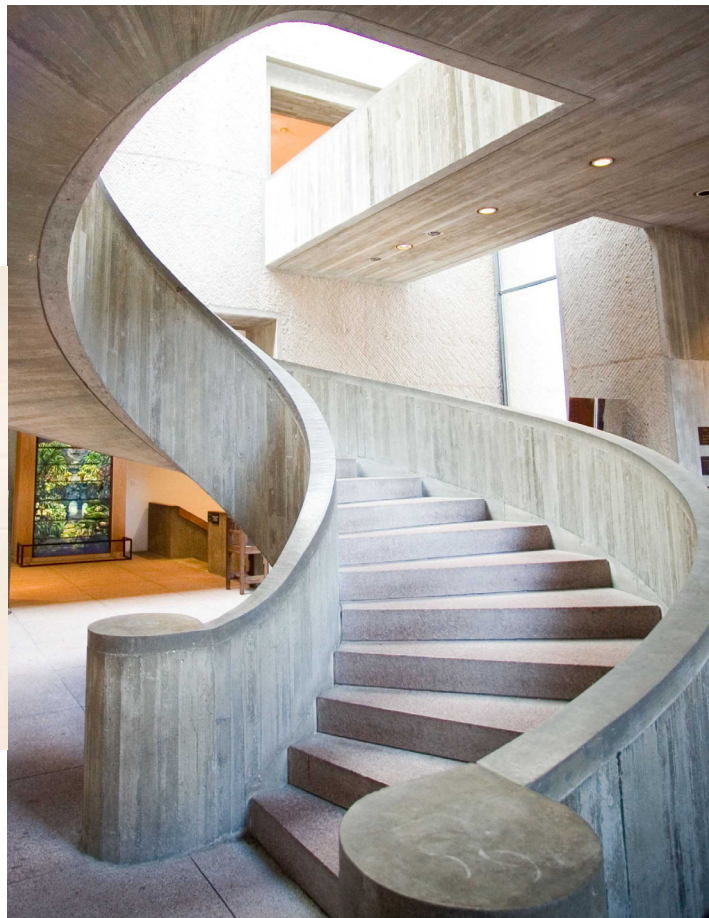
HOW DID YOU HEAR ABOUT THIS PROGRAM?

HOW TO JOIN

Open application begins **June 1, 2019**. Complete the application form on the back of this brochure and supply:

- Two letters of recommendation (can be mailed separately from this application)
- Brief essay (500 words or less) that responds to the following prompts:
 - Tell us about yourself!
 - Describe your interest in the arts.
 - Consider one issue affecting your community or peers that you would like to see change.
 - Discuss an experience you had working with a group. Describe the situation, any problems that arose, how they were resolved, and the outcome of the experience. What was your role in the group?

Application must be received by September 25, 2019. Applicants will be contacted for interviews by October 2, 2019.
