

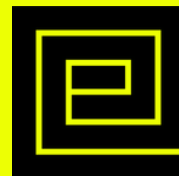
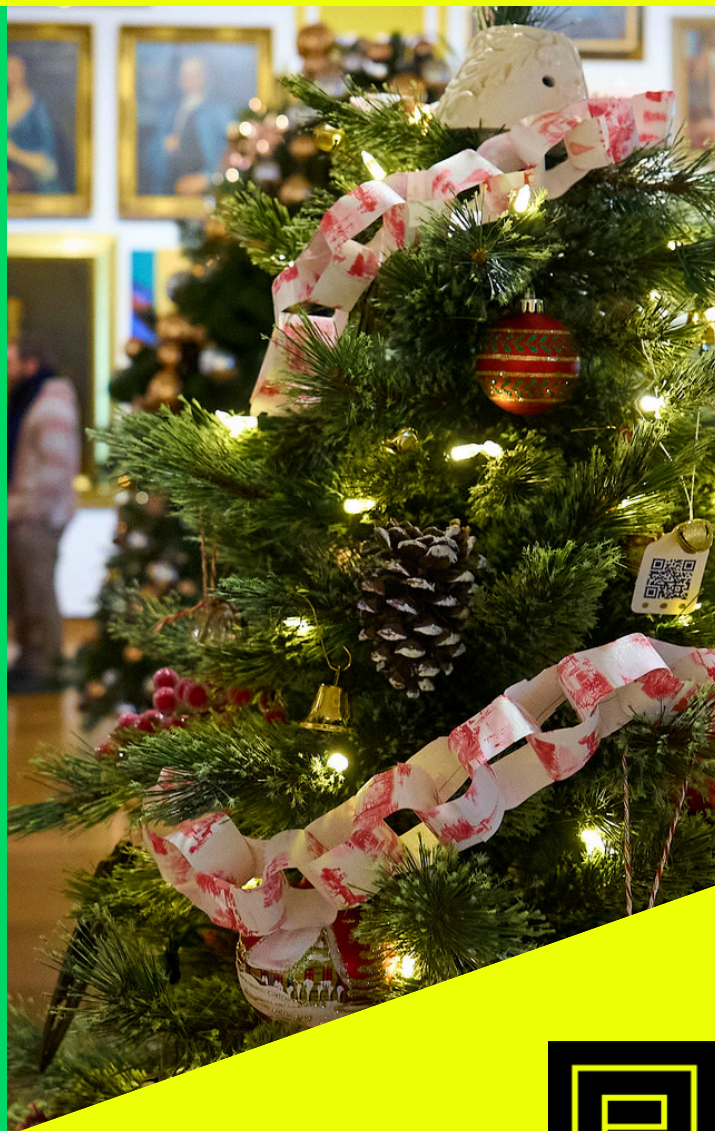



- 11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

### **Festival Dates:**

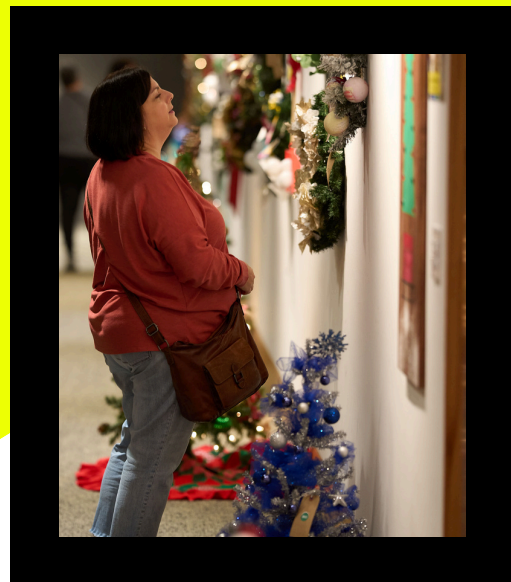
- December 4–13, 2025

### **Design Guidelines**

- Trees and décor must be artificial
- Sugar-based items (e.g., candy canes) may be used
- Fresh fruit, vegetables, or organic materials are not permitted
- Attach labels to any items that could separate (e.g., tree skirts)
- Securely fasten all ornaments and decorations
- Exhibits must conform to fire regulation codes of the State of New York, County of Onondaga and City of Syracuse.
- All exhibits must be inspected after set-up.
