



To protect the artwork, and for the safety of other guests, the guidelines below must be followed when photographing and filming at The Everson.

- Professional photo shoots must be scheduled in advance. No drop-in appointment will be taken.
- No groups of over 20 will be permitted for photo shoots.
- Photography and filming must be conducted without disruption to Everson operations or limitation to the accessibility of exhibitions, entrances/exits, doorways, pathways, and high traffic areas.
- All participants must be at least (5) five feet away from any artwork.
- Flash photography, tripods, monopods (including selfie sticks) and other photographic equipment are not permitted inside the Museum.
- Camera bags may be restricted at staff discretion based on size.
- The use of drones by guests is not permitted in the Museum for the safety and security of other guests.
- Photography and filming are permitted for private, non-commercial use only. Photos and videos may not be published, sold, reproduced, distributed, or otherwise commercially exploited in any manner.
- Unless otherwise noted, photography of temporary exhibitions or borrowed works of art is not permitted.
- There is no food and drink permitted in the galleries.
